-Dance Demonstration interlinking discipline with education.

-Impact of dance on the body & mind- musical sound & its impact in evolving movements, how Dance enhances our observation & relaxes our body & mind.

-Make the beneficiaries understand how devotion & dedication is required in learning & practicing ART.

-Interaction of participants with performing artists.
